

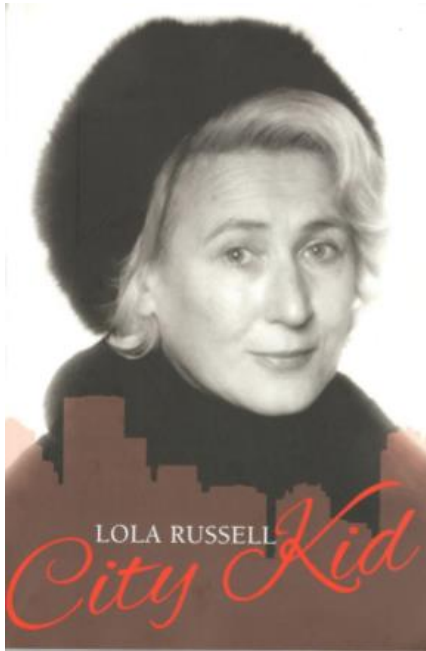


## HOTHAM HISTORY PROJECT INC.
